**NOTICE TO THE SHAREHOLDERS OF OSTRUM GLOBAL MINVOL EQUITY (THE "SUB-FUND")**

Dear Madam, dear Sir,

We are writing to you in our capacity as directors of the board of the SICAV (the "**Board**"), which is managed by Natixis Investment Managers International, a management company<sup>1</sup> belonging to the BPCE Group (the "**Management Company**").

Shareholders of the Sub-Fund are hereby informed of the following changes to the prospectus of the SICAV (the "**Prospectus**") related to the Sub-Fund.

Capitalised terms used in this notice shall have the meaning given to them in the Prospectus.

In order to provide investors with a clear and straightforward understanding of the pursued objectives, the Delegated Investment Manager felt it was important to review the ESG policy criteria included in the Sub-Fund's SFDR Annex. In this context, it is proposed to introduce a minimum share of sustainable investments with an environmental objective that are aligned with the EU Taxonomy of 2%.

Additionally, the Delegated Investment Manager intends to transition from the selectivity approach previously employed by the Sub-Fund to a rating improvement approach. This new methodology will incorporate:

- An objective to maintain an average ESG rating superior to that of its Filtered Investment Universe. This universe is defined as the initial investment universe, the MSCI World All Countries DNR index, from which the 20% of issuers with the lowest ESG ratings are excluded.
- The integration of the average ESG rating for the Sub-Fund and its associated average ESG rating of the Filtered Investment Universe into the indicators used to measure the achievement of each ESG characteristic.

Furthermore, the Sub-Fund's previous commitment to exclude 20% of its initial investment universe through the implementation of its ESG strategy has been removed.

**The changes described above will become effective on 27 July 2026 and will be reflected in the updated Prospectus dated June 2026. Shareholders may ask for redemption and conversion<sup>2</sup> of their Shares free of charge during a period of at least one (1) month starting from the date of this notice to the Effective Date.**
